



Northern Colorado Chapter, Colorado Archaeological Society Release of Liability and Non-Disclosure Form

I, _____, as a member in good standing of the Colorado Archeological Society am participating in _____, organized and led by the Northern Colorado Chapter.

I agree to abide by all rules and regulations established by the Northern Colorado Chapter of the Colorado Archaeological Society (NCC-CAS) and/or any organization(s), agency(s) or person(s) that may have jurisdiction or regulatory power of any nature concerning the activities or field trips organized by NCC-CAS. Participant(s) must and hereby agree to bear the total costs of any damages and fines resulting from his/her/their actions, thereby releasing NCC-CAS, its officers, representatives and personnel from any liability whatsoever.

The participant(s) realizes that there are certain dangers inherent in any activity and hereby releases NCC-CAS from all liability regarding any and all activity. Either acts of happenstance (such as, but not limited to, snakebite, poisonous plants and insects) self-induced dangers (such as, but not limited to, climbing on loose rocks or ledgers, walking along cliff edges, exposure and dehydration, etc.) and any other situation not before described that may jeopardize the safety or well-being of the participant(s) shall not be the liability of NCC-CAS, its officers, representatives or personnel.

The participant(s) authorize NCC-CAS, its officers, representatives and personnel involved in sponsored activities, in their broadest sense, to administer emergency treatment for any accident, injury or illness incurred during the period of the above-named activity and to enlist, contract for or hire any professional medical and/or dental services they feel are necessary for the safety and well-being of the participant(s). It is further understood that the cost of such emergency transportation and/or rescue services is to be borne in full by the participant(s) and NCC-CAS and its officers or representatives are released from any obligation or liability concerning such costs.

We expect our members and other Chapter guests to abide by the CAS Code of Ethics, Social Media Policy and Cultural Resources Protection Policy and Guidelines.
